## ***XAT Exam Pattern 2026***

The XAT exam pattern is made to test a candidate's decision-making skills, language ability, maths skills, and general knowledge. In XAT 2026, there will be a total of 95 questions divided into four main sections:

- **Decision Making** – 21 questions
- **Verbal and Logical Ability** – 26 questions
- **Quantitative Ability and Data Interpretation** – 28 questions
- **General Knowledge** – 20 questions

Each question is worth 1 mark, so the total marks are 95. You can check the detailed breakup in the table below.
